Description:

"... my will & desire is that my belovd wife Francis Blassingame shall have one bead & firni-
ture, one horse saddle & bridle, viz, (the gray horse), one trunk, & the youse of the whole of
the land during her natural life, whareon I now reside.

Also it is my will & desire that my daughter Elizabeth Bradshaw shall have one negro boy name
Jolly & the heirs of Benjamin Blassingame shall have [\$5] in cash, & also the heirs of Rachel
Ward to have [\$5], & also my dughter Sarah Boles to have [\$5], & also my daughter Polly
Awtrey to have one negro girl by the name of Hannah, also my son James Blassingame to
have one negro woman by the name of Rachel & two of her children, one a boy by the name
of Jacob & one a girl by the name of Charity, & all my interest in the contemplated land lot-
tery, viz, two draws for which I gave in as a Revolutionary Soldier, also my daughter Nancy
Awtrey to have a negro girl by the name of Chany . . ."

Description:

"I give to my beloved wife Elizabeth [#28A/1], during her natural life or widow hood, three ne-
groes, viz, Charles, Violet, and Robin, one choice horse as she may prefer, and one choice of
the beds & furniture.

I give to my daughter Polly Fambrough [#28A2] two negroes, viz, Lucy & Sam, and what I have
given heretofore to her.

I give to my daughter Frances Merriwether [#28A3] two negroes, viz, Jolly and Simon, together
with what I may have give her heretofore.

I give to my daughter Susan Fambrough [#28A4] three negroes, viz, Lucy and her child, and
Henry, together with what I have heretofore given to be held by my son Elijah Bradshaw as
agent for my said daughter Susan for her use and support during her natural life and, at her
death, to be . . . equally divided between the surviving children of my said daughter Susan
Fambrough.

I give to my son Justice Bradshaw two negroes, viz, John and Sam, and the tracts of land in
Greene Co. whereon I now live . . . together with what I may have hereunto given him.

I give to my son William Bradshaw two negroes, viz, Miles and Lowis, together with what I may
have hereunto given him.

I give to my son Elijah Bradshaw three negroes, viz, Jacob, Murphy, and Dick, together with
what I may have heretofore given him.

My will is that all my property, both personal and real, not heretofore disposed of, be by Executors to be hereinafter mentioned, sold so soon after my deceased, as convenient, and the proceeds together, with what may be owing me, be equally divided between my wife and six children, i.e., Polly Fambrough, Francis Merriwether, Susan Fambrough, Justice Bradshaw, William Bradshaw, and Elijah Bradshaw, and my two grand daughters Betsy Ann [#28A11] and Frances Fambrough [#28A12], children of my daughter Sarah [#28A1], deceased, together to come in as one, receiving each one eighth part, share and share alike. I appoint my son Elijah Bradshaw agent for my daughter Susan Fambrough . . .”
