Description:

"I lend and bequeath to my loveing wife Elizebeth Janett Head two negroes, viz, one named Wegan and the other named Sarah, together with four feather beds and all my household furniture, working tools, and stock of hogs and cattle and two work horses, and I lend my sorrel mare to my wife Elizebeth dureing her life, and the two first colts that the said mare may have. The present colt the said mare now has, I give to my son Benjamin Simon Head [#15215] and the next the mare may have, I give to my son James Head [#15216], and the rest of the colts that the said sorrel mare may have, to be equally devided amongst all my children.

I give and bequeath to my daughter Sarah Fortson [#15211] one negro girl named Lisey, one feather bed and furniture, saddle & bridle, all now in her possession.

My will and desire is that my land lying on Van's Creek, after the death of my wife, be devided between my two sons, Benjamin Simon Head and James Head, and the remaining part of my property to be devided by my Executors in manner and form following, begining with Martha Head [#15212] and so down to James Head, each of them to have one negro, feather bed, furniture, and saddle and bridle, and . . . then the ballance of my Estate to be equally devided amongst those of my children from Martha down to James Head – and my tract of land of [200] acres in Wilkes County on Kettle Creek to be sold by my Executors to pay my just debts, and, if my wife Elizebeth Janet Head should marry, the land and property not willed to my wife to be taken out of her hands to support the children at the distrabutation of my Executors.

. . .

NB – The increase of the negro woman Sarah, willed to my wife, to be equally devided among my children at the general distrabutation and, if any of my present surviveing children should die without heir lawfully begotten of their body, then their portion to be equally devided amongst those of my children that may be alive."

Item 2: I desire that all of my just debts be paid, as soon after my death as may be convenient to my executors hereafter named.

Item 3: I give and bequeath unto my son Jesse W. Fears the silver watch I have been accustomed to wear. Also the following negroes, to wit, Lewis valued at one thousand dollars, Harriett a girl valued at eight hundred dollars, Susan a girl valued at five hundred dollars, all of which save said watch together with the one thousand dollars to him heretofore advanced by me are to be by him accounted for according to the foregoing valuation and deducted from his share upon the final and general distribution of my estate.

Item 4: I give and bequeath unto my son John H. Fears [#15216A/1, my rifle, also the following negroes heretofore by me loaned to him and now in his possession, to wit, Hampton valued at eight hundred dollars, Clary valued at five hundred dollars, Robert valued at four hundred dollars, Amis valued at three hundred dollars, Frances valued at one hundred fifty dollars and also one wagon and two mules valued at one hundred fifty dollars, all of which said property save said rifle together with the one thousand dollars by me heretofore advanced to him are to be by him accounted for according to the foregoing valuation and deducted from his share upon the final and general distribution of my estate.

Item 5: I give and bequeath to my son James T. Fears the following negroes, to wit, Washington valued at twelve hundred dollars, Judy valued at eight hundred dollars and Foster a boy valued at four hundred dollars. All of which property together with the one thousand dollars by me heretofore advanced to him he is to account for according to the foregoing valuation and the same is to be deducted from his share in the general and final distribution of my estate.

Item 6: I give and bequeath my daughter Margaret A. Martin, wife of Felix B. Martin, her sole and separate use free from the debts and liabilities of her present or any future husband during her natural life and at her death to her children, the following negroes, to wit, Hiram a man valued at twelve hundred dollars, Amanda a girl valued at eight hundred dollars, Fanny valued at four hundred dollars, also eight hundred dollars in cash to be paid to her as soon as may be convenient to my executors after my death all of which property together with two hundred dollars worth by me heretofore advanced to her is to be by her accounted according to the foregoing valuation without interest on said money and deducted from her share at the final and general distribution of my estate.

Item 7: I give and bequeath to my son Henry Clay Fears one thousand dollars in money and twenty three hundred dollars in negro property, said money and negroes to vest in him only at his maturity and then to be delivered to him by my executors, said negroes to be selected by my wife and to be appraised by three appraisers, one to be selected by my executors, one by the said Henry Clay Fears and the third by the two so selected. All which said money and

negroes so appraised shall be deducted from his share at the final and general distribution of my estate, it is my intention that he receive no hire for the negroes until he arrives at age or any interest on the money.

Item 8: I give and bequeath unto my two daughters Eugenia A. and Cornelia A. Fears respectively at their respective maturity or marriages each twenty three hundred dollars in negroes to be selected and appraised in the same manner as directed in the foregoing terms relative to my son Henry C. Fears, also one thousand dollars to each respectively from time to time as their wants may require and as my executors may deem proper and without injury to my estate. No interest to be charged said fund in the event it is not paid over immediately upon the marriage or maturity of said daughters respectively. Said negroes and money not to be delivered until said respective marriages or majorities and at which time only the titles to said property is to vest in my said daughters free from the liabilities, debts or control of any of their future husbands for all which property and money they are to account and the value thereof is to be deducted from their respective shares upon the final distribution of my estate.

Item 9: All of my estate real and personal except as hereinafter excepted and exempt as herein before specifically bequeathed, I desire to be left together and managed by my executors during the lifetime of my wife Elizabeth Fears and in case of her death until the majority of my youngest son Henry Clay Fears during all which period the same is taken chargeable with the support and maintenance of my said wife and our minor children Eugenia A., Cornelia A. and Henry C. Fears and also the education of said children. And at the death of my said wife or should she die before the majority of the said Henry C. then at his majority all my personal property and real estate as hereinafter exempted I desire it to be sold and the proceeds together with my negroes not before specifically bequeathed to be equally divided amongst my children each one accounting for his or her specific legacy or advancement as hereinbefore directed and each daughter receiving here share in Trust for her sole and separate use free from the debts, liabilities or control of them or their present or future husbands; provided nevertheless that my wife who is also hereinafter nominated Executrix may at her option advance to any or each of my children at any time any negroes or money not exceeding in value such child's share in my estate, each daughter so advanced receiving such advancements upon the same trust and conditions as under this will attach to her entire share in my estate. And each child so advanced to receipt to my executors for such advancement and the same to be deduced from his or her share on final division provided also upon the marriage of said minor children or either of them, the support and maintenance of each such child so marrying shall cease to be a charge upon my estate as before willed.

Item 10: I hereby authorize my executors to sell my lands in the state of Alabama in such manner as they deem best or if they see proper to continue to cultivate or to rent the same.

Item 11: I hereby nominate Felix B. Martin trustee for my daughter Margaret A. Martin to reserve and as trustee to manage the property in this will bequeathed to her for her sole and separate use during her life and at her death to pay over the same to her children in fee according to the Trusts herein created.

Item 12: I hereby nominate and appoint my son Jesse W. Fears Trustee for my daughters Eugenia A. and Cornelia A. I further give to my said wife such part or portion of the stock, provisions, farming utensils, household and kitchen furniture which I may die possessed, as she may think mindful and choose for the purposes hereafter named to be held by her during her life or widowhood to her own proper uses and the uses following, that is to say, it is my will that the said lands in this clause mentioned be not rented out and not worked or used by anyone except my wife during her natural life or widowhood with hands as she may have control of and that with the proceeds of the lands, negroes, and other property by this clause devised and bequeathed she shall support and educate the children (also my Grandchild hereinafter named if it shall remain with her under her direction and guardianship) till they and each of them shall arrive respectively to the age of twenty-one or marry, at which time she shall divide off to each of my own children respectively an equal distributive share of said stock, farming utensils, household and kitchen furniture. I wish the woodland and timber on the land in this clause named not to be wasted nor needlessly cut down. - the stock and other perishable property she may choose and take at her death or intermarriage shall go together with their increase to my own children then living and the representative or representatives of a child or children of mine to be equally divided between them the representative or representatives to take the share its parent would be entitled to, to have and to hold the same in like manner and subject to the restrictions imposed on the legacies hereinafter specified and given to my children named and if my said daughter Artemesia should not survive the period of my said wife's death or marriage then the said lands devised to my wife for life or widowhood shall go to and be divided between my surviving children in the way and on the terms and restrictions prescribed in disposing of the negroes herein bequeathed to my said wife, the representative always standing instead of the deceased parent.

The representative or representatives so specified to take to them and their heirs forever, but the child or children of mine then surviving then to take and hold in the like manner and on the terms and limitations imposed herein on their respective legacies.
- To my daughter Artemesia Head, I bequeath in addition to what has heretofore been specified the following negroes to-wit; Seaborn and Merit, Indy and Almanie, Dick and Aleck, Harriet and Mary Ann and Chloe for and during her natural life and at her death to go to the issue the child or children of her body, living at the time of her death to them and their heirs forever. And if my said daughter Artemesia should die without issue living, that is a child at the time of her death then I desire and direct that said negroes given to her for life shall then be in line and the surviving representative or representatives of a deceased child of mine the said representative so surviving to take them and their heirs forever but my said surviving child or children to take and hold in like manner and under life limitations and restrictions with those imposed on their respective legacies specifically given.

I give and bequeath to my Granddaughter Martha T. Head [#23551] the following negroes to-wit; Lethy and her child Ross, Tiletha and Peter and Violet, for and during her natural life and at her death to go to such child or children issue of her body as she may then have living at the time of her death to him or them and their heirs forever. If my Granddaughter Marth should die without such child or children living at the time of her death the said negroes bequeathed to her shall go to and be equally divided between those of my children that may survive her and to the surviving representative or representatives of a deceased child of mine, my said surviving child to take the same on the limitations and restrictions placed on his respective legacy heretofore and hereby given, the representatives however shall take absolutely to them and their heirs forever. I also give my said Granddaughter her support and education in the way specified in the first clause of this my will provided on the condition that she shall remain with my wife as her Guardian, otherwise she shall have nothing for her support or education other than her specific legacy.

By word representative, I mean the child or children of my child or children in limiting over the portions respectively in case of death of one of my legatees, it not my wish that my granddaughter Martha Head, should not come in or take at all either as a child or the representative of a child I have provided for her in the Sixth Clause.

All the residue of my estate not herein specifically divided and bequeathed after paying all necessary expenses of executing my will, I wish to be equally divided between my three children herein named and such others as may be living at my death and their representative or representatives of a deceased child, except my granddaughter Martha Head, the representative in this and all cases to get parents portion, whether the residue consists of money, notes, accounts or other property, I make that disposition of it the surviving children and the representatives of a deceased child or children who take under this clause shall hold and take under the limitations and on the terms imposed on each respective legacy of theris. It is my will never the less that if a child should be born to me of my wife after executing this my will that he or she should come in for an equal share of my estate to be taken from each ones portion provided each child shall be living at my death and shall take and hold it on the same terms and limitations and like restrictions imposed on each of my children named. It is my intention that in all cases the increase shall follow the disposition of the specified property, It is also my will that whenever a division shall be called for by my will, my Executors and Execturix shall nominate five discrete persons to make it, whose report, when made, shall be final.”

Pearson [#2513] to be subject in no wise for the payment of any husband’s debts the property may be used and employed under the authority and power of said

- trustee as he may think will best promote the objects of said trust allowing the said Sara Ann C. to have and use the same for the support of herself and children during her life and at her death equally to be divided among her children share and share alike.
- I give to James A. Merriwether to hold in trust for the purposes hereinafter named the following negroes with their increase from this day to-wit Luke Minty Lonza Page Amanda Annis Charity Jr. John and Susan to hold the same for the sole and separate use of my said daughter Lucy Ann E. T. Brown [#2514] to be subject in no wise for the payment of any husbands debts the property may be used and employed under the authority and power of said trustee as he may think will best secure the objects of the trust allowing the said Lucy Ann E. T. to have and use the same for the support of herself and children during her lifetime and at her death to be equally divided among her children share and share alike.
- I give to James A. Merriwether to hold in trust for the purpose hereinafter named the following property negroes with their increase from this day, Polly Jim Enoch Kitchen Ailsey Cloey Tamar Silas Richmond and Jim, to have and to hold the same for the sole and separate use of my daughter Artemisa [#2515] to have and use the same for the support of herself and children should she have any during her life and at her death to be equally divided among her children.
- I give to James A. Merriwether to hold in trust for the purpose hereinafter named the following property negroes with their increase from this day to-wit; Leathy Rose Betsey Lucinda Jerry King Izabel Green Tillitha and Mariah to have and to hold the same for the sole and separate use of my grand daughter Martha T. Head [#23551] and not subject to the payments of the debts of any husband the property may be used and employed under the authority and power of said trustee as he may think will best promote the objects of said trust allowing the said Martha T. Head to have said use of the same for the support of herself and any children she may have during her life time and at her death the property to be equally divided among said children share and share alike, but if she die leaving no child or descendants of child alive at her death said property to return to my estate and be equally divided among my children the title to the same to be vested in trust and not otherwise as is provided in each bequest made to said children and or the same purposes for the uses and under the same and identical restriction limitations and uses the gift being to their sole and separate use.
- I give all my lands not given to my wife to be equally divided among my children and grand child and to be held in trust and all the other property which I have given them to use and applied and controlled as such and to be subject to the same uses and under the same and identical restrictions and limitations and uses as the other bequests herein made of them the gift being sole and separate use.
- I give to my wife all my negroes not herein disposed of to be equally divided as contemplated by the former bequests to be equally divided between my wife, children and grand child, my wife's share to be held during her life and divided at her death like the other property she has received, the share going to my grandchild and all that she inherits or receives under this will to be held in trust for her sole and separate use as before provided and at her death without child or children to revert and be disposed of as heretofore provided, the property which my children shall receive every particle of it I give to them in trust as before and to said trustee to have and to hold for their sole and separate use and upon the same restriction and limitations and for the same uses and purposes and trust which I have more fully stated in a previous part of my will.”

“ From a variety of reason I have thought proper to make a codicil to my will I do not desire that my grand daughter should have any interest either in the real of personal estate except the negroes I have given her respectively and by name and I revoke so much of my will as gives her more. I give to James A Merriwether to hold in trust Rachel Henry and Martha for the

sole and separate use of Sara Ann C. Pearson [#2513]. I give him to hold in trust Harry Susan bought of Bridges, Milly and Cate for the sole and separate use of daughter Artemisa [#2515]. I give him in trust Judy Dennis Susan (Phinby daughter) and Jane for the sole and separate use of Lucy Brown [#2514] my daughter to hold all of said property for the same uses restriction limitations and conditions as the property before and herein given to the same children I have not given Ann Pearson as many negroes as my other children because I consider I have paid for and loaned the difference to her husband.”

Questions by the Court

Q: Where and in what year were you born?

A: Culppepper County State of Virginia in the year [1763]

Q: Have you any record of your age; if so, where is it?

A: I have a record of my age. It is at my son’s James Head in Gynette County State of Georgia.

Q: Where were you living when called into service; where have you lived since the Revolution-
ary War and where do you live now?

A: State of South Carolina, Spartanburgh district. I have lived since the Revolutionary [War] in Elbert, Gynette, & Morgan County. I have now no permanent home. Have and still live with my son in Gynette County and at Mr. Stephen Jones in Morgan County where . . . staying latterly.

Q: How were you called into service; were you draughted; did you volunteer or were you a substitute, and if a substitute for whom?

A: All my service was as a volunteer.

Q: State the names of some of the Regular officers who were with the Troops when you served . . .

A: General Morgan and Green [?] Pickins & others the general circumstances have been detailed as recollected in the foregoing declaration.

Q: Did you ever receive a discharge from the service; and if so by whom was it give and what became of it?

A: I received a discharge for some portion of the service, which has been lost or destroyed long since.

Q: State the names of persons to whom you are known in your present neighborhood and who can testify as to your character for verracity and their belief of your services as a soldier of the Revolution.

A: Stephen Jones & Thomas Hammond are both well acquainted with me and will testify that they believe I was a soldier of the Revolution.
