"I, John A. Head [#1116] of the county of Franklin and state of Kentucky, do hereby make my last will and testament in manner of ___ following that is ___, I desire that my executor herein after named, shall immediately upon my decease, take my ___ to pay off all my just debts and funeral expenses out of such means as are hereinafter designated and all of such other means as shall come when lands not particularly named.

2nd. After the payment of my debts, I give to my wife Polly Head [#5432] the farm and tract of land on which I now live, a negro girl named Violet to have and to hold during her natural life also my household and kitchen furniture and farming utensils to have and hold forever to be disposed of as she pleases.

3rd. At the death of my said wife, I give to my friend Ben P. Duvall the said farm and tract of land on which I now live as aforesaid in trust for the use of my son Joseph Head [#11168]. My said trustee hereby being empowered to sell, lease or rent the said tract of land as in his judgment may seem best and apply the proceeds thereof to the ___? of the said Joseph and I further desire that al the death of my wife the said Negro girl Violett and her increase if any be sold by my executor and the proceeds of the sale equally divided among all my children subject to exceptions that are made and to be hereafter made in relation to land devised to my sons Joseph and Benjamin [#11161].

4th. I have heretofore given and conveyed to my children William Head [#11162], Permelia Triplett [#11163] and Nancy Story [#11169] each fifty acres of land out to a tract by me in Davies County, Kentucky and I desire that the residue of said tract of land be divided as follows with on 50 acre lot to Sarah Wright [#11164] one 50 acre lot to my son Frances Head [#1116A] and the residue of said tract of land supposed to contain about seventy acres, I wish my executor to sell and apply to the payment of my debts or to the support of my wife and family as he may under existing circumstances think proper. But, as there is still one fifty acre lot of land left on said tract and unappropriated I hereby give and bequeath the same to my said executor in trust for the use and benefit of my son Ben T. Head and his wife and children hereby clothing ? my executor with the same power of selling, leasing or renting the same as are conferred upon Ben P. Duvall as trustee for my son Joseph.

5th. I justly owe the heirs of Elijah Kendall [#1113/1], desc. the sum of one hundred dollars which I enjoin upon my children to pay who has had devised to them or conveyed to him but if by mutual agreement it is not made up promptly paid over I enjoin it on my executor to see its payments out of any means coming to his hands not otherwise appropriated and I further desire if there are any means left in unappropriated ___ my executor accruing out of the unappropriated land of the 70 acres above I desire that the same shall be equally divided among my children as follows: _____? Ben T. Head, William Head, Permelia Triplett, Sarah Wright, Henry H. Head [#11165] and Joseph Head, Nancy Story and Frances Head and I have a young sorrel horse (colt?) usually called with name of my son Alfred [#1116B], deceased. I desire that my wife, Polly Head have said colt when our benefit forever.

And, lastly, I do ___ and appoint my brother Benjamin Head [#1114] executor to my last will and testament hereby revoking all other or former wills or testaments by me made ___ whereof ___ my hand and seal this 18th day of September 1847.

“In the name of God Amen, I, Martin J. Sebree of the County of Franklin and State of Kentucky, being of sound mind and bodily afflicted, knowing that my time here is but short here on this earth, make this my last will and testament in manner and following. That is to say:

- 1st. I devise that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid and for which I subject my estate.
- 2nd. I desire that my executor hereinafter mentioned sell all my land, which I may die seized and possessed, also my personal property.
- 3rd. It is my desire that the proceeds of my entire estate be equally divided among my five daughters, namely; Martha Ann Head [#11112/1], wife of James Head [#11112]; Mary Jane Holder, wife of T.J. Holder; Elizabeth Francis Linn, wife of Madison E. Linn; Amanda Malvina Romans, wife of Eliza Romans and Sarina Catharine Hudson, wife of Fabricus Hudson.
- 4th. As my daughter, Martha Ann Head has departed this life, her living heirs are to have her part of my estate.
- 5th. As my daughter, Mary Jane Holder has no bodily heirs and if she never has any heirs at her death the amount she receives from my estate is to fall back to my heirs and to be equally divided among them or their heirs.
- 6th. Whatever I have advanced to my children in land or money or any other property I direct shall be charged to them as part of their legacy
- 7th. I direct whatever my daughter, Amanda Malvina Romans gets of my estate shall be invested in land for the benefit of her and her heirs.
- 8th. I direct whatever my daughter, Sarina Catharine Hudson receives of my estate be invested in land for the benefit of her and her heirs.

9th. I hereby appoint Madison E. Linn my executor. I hear by revoke all other or former wills by me made. Witness my name and seal this 9th of March 1871.

“In the name of God Amen, I Jasper Clayton of Franklin County and State of Kentucky, do hereby make this my last will and testament, revoking all other wills by me made. I desire all my just debts paid that I have contracted since I have taken the Bankrupt law, or Bankruptcy. Section the first: I desire and will that my wife Elizabeth Clayton, late Elizabeth Tackett have all the land or farm where on I now live, which I purchased of Joseph Yates, containing eight three acres, lying and being in the counties of Scott, Franklin and Owen to have during her natural life and two featherbeds and bed steads and all necessary bed clothing for the same, one clock, two cows and calves, if they have any and eight chairs and one chicken house or mare, if any, three tables and ___ and the cooking vessels and __ gallon kettle and eight shoats and I will and desire that at the death of my wife, Elizabeth Clayton, the land which I now live on that it shall be disposed of as follows: Whereas R. A. Jameson caused my land to be sold for going his security and hold his note for two hundred and sixty two dollars due January the 26th day 1866. I will and desire that if the R. A. Jameson failes to pay off the said two hundred and sixty two dollars with interest on the same in my lifetime so that I get the money in hand, that his children, my grandchildren, which are my daughter Elizabeth's children, Elizabeth Jameson, late Elizabeth Clayton, namely James W. Jameson, Milly Jameson, now Milly Blythe and Nancy Jameson, now Nancy Morgan, John Alfred Jameson and Malinda Frances Jameson. I will and desire that my grandchildren as above named, Robert A. Jameson' s children shall only have twenty five dollars of my estate and that at my wife Elizabeth Clayton's death, which will be five dollars per heir. I will and desire that my daughter, Lucy Head, late Lucy Clayton [#11165/2], wife of H. H. Head [#11165] have one hundred dollars of my estate at the death of my wife Elizabeth Clayton and if her husband H. H. Head pays off two debts in claims I hold on him. One is a note for sixty eight dollars due September 1867 the other is a note that I assigned to Nicholas Taylor for about two hundred and ninety dollars with some credits paid on it, now if the said H. H. Head pays both of them debts, my daughter, Lucy Head shall have her equal share of my estate and if he does not she

shall have only one hundred dollars at my wifes death. I will and desire that my granddaughter Mary Boulin Bruce, late Mary Clayton shall have fifteen dollars of my estate, but if she dies without heirs, no person shall collect or get the money or if she dies without any heirs. I will and desire that John A. Abbott, Mildred Tackett, late Mildred Abbott, J. N. Abbott, Charles Abbott and Mieve Abbott, my grandchildren, heirs of William C. Abbott and children of my daughter, Mary Abbott, deceased, late Mary Clayton shall have the balance of my estate after all debts are paid and at the death of my wife Elizabeth Clayton, all the land that I now own at the death of my wife Elizabeth Clayton. I will and desire that Dabrier Manfous, a boy about 13 or 14 years of age that lives with me now, shall have one bay horse colt, which will be one year old May next, one young white cow, one high bed stead and one featherbed and all necessary clothing for the same and one Choire hog for service already rendered to me for the same. Whereas I hereto set my hand this the 22nd day of March 1870.

- Third- It is my will that my negroes should remain in the Family, and for the purpose of effecting this object and at the same time to insure a fair division, It is my will that as soon as convenient after my death my executors shall offer them for sale Publicly to those members of my Family who shall wish to purchase them but not to strangers and my grandchildren, Samuel Ellis [#112613] and Zacharias Ellis [#112612] shall have the privilege of bidding on such of them as they may wish and my grandson Henry McMakin [#1126111], shall be represented at the sale by his guardian my son James M. Head (also my executor) is to be at liberty to buy such as he may wish, if he is willing to give more than the other members of the Family are willing to give.
- Fourth- It is understood that I have heretofore given to my daughter Julia Ann [#11261] and her husband John C. Mount [#11261/2], land valued at \$2,210 and three negroes value at \$750, \$400 & \$300 and of said property so given value in all at \$3,700, my grandchildren Samuel and Zacharias Ellis and Henry McMakin in all probability unto receive no benefit and as it is my wish that my children and those who stand in their places shall receive a fair and just proportion of my estate, and as I have heretofore given to my son James M. Head about the same amount that I have given to my daughter and her husband therefore it is my will that after the payment of my debts and funeral expenses and the expenses of carrying this will into effect my estate including the sale of my negroes and personal, cash and debts and also in dividing the proceeds of some land lately bought by me of Belwood which my executor is hereby declared to sale at public sale on a reasonable credit and convey to the purchaser, Shall be equally divided into two parts and one part shall be to my son James M. Head his heirs executor & administrators and out of the other part then should be paid to my grand son Zacharias Ellis nine hundred and twenty five dollars and to my grandson Samuel Ellis nine hundred and twenty five dollars and to my great grandson Henry McMakin nine hundred and twenty five dollars which sum to each will make them equal to any other children of my daughter Julia Ann by John C. Mount so far as my estate is concerned.
- Fifth- It is further my will that after paid Zacharias, Samuel, and Henry shall have received each the said sum of \$925. Whatever is left of the part from which said sums are or may be taken shall be divided into seven equal parts of which one part shall go to Zachariah Ellis and one part shall go to Samuel Ellis, and part shall go to Henry McMakin and the other four parts shall go to my daughter Julia Ann Mount.
- Sixth- It is my will that my son James M. Head shall be my executor to carry out the promises of this my last will and testament.
- Seventh- It is also my will that if any of the said legates the said Samuel, Zacharias, or Henry should die without leaving issue of his body then at the death of such legatee the portion herein bequeathed to him shall be divided among any other legates herein named in the same manner as herein before directed or among those living and the representation of such as may have died that is to say if Samuel Ellis were to die without issue of his body the legacy I have given him shall be divided into two parts, and one part go to James M. Head and the other part to be divided into six parts one of which should go Zacharias Ellis, one to Henry McMakin if living and the other four go to Julia Ann Mount or to her children by John C. Mount. If she were dead and a similar division to be made of the legacy of Zachariah or of that to Henry McMakin. If either of them should die without issue of his body at his death.
- Eighth- It will be understood that I have given to my daughter Julia Ann and her husband John C. Mount a Negro woman named Lucy who has not before been allocated to and during her intermarriage with Stephen Ellis [#11261/1], I also gave her and said Ellis a boy slave and her children by Ellis got this benefit of said boy. And her children by Mount got or will get the benefit of the gift of Lucy. I conceive that the provision of this will do such justices us between the children of Stephen Ellis and the children of said Mount by my daughter Julia Ann.
